

## Le Moyne College & Syracuse University iSchool - Fast Track Partnership

The Fast Track program enables qualified students to start their graduate coursework in their senior year of undergraduate study. The program permits students to earn their master's degree within one year after graduation from their undergraduate institution. Rather than a traditional 4+1 program, the Fast Track program also allows students to enter the workforce after graduation and complete their M.S. part-time in an online program.

The Syracuse iSchool offers Master's programs in Applied Data Science, Information Systems, and Library & Information Science.

TIMELINE OF STUDY	
During 2 <sup>nd</sup> semester of Jr. Year – June 1 <sup>st</sup> for Spring graduates and December 1 <sup>st</sup> for Fall graduates	Apply for admission in the Master's program you are interested in. 3 IST Credit Hours	Enroll in one appropriate IST course during first semester of senior year, per the iSchool advising team (iAdvising@syr.edu) – Le Moyne students receive the SU tuition rate for non-matriculated undergraduate students for class #1
6 IST Credit Hours	Fast Track students have the opportunity to take an additional three to six credits of graduate study during the second semester of senior year – you receive a 100% scholarship to cover 100% of the tuition for the two remaining courses
Summer/Fall after Le Moyne Graduation	You must provide an official degree bearing transcript to Syracuse University. After receipt of the transcript, assuming you are in good academic standing and maintain good citizenship, you will be officially admitted to the Syracuse M.S. program.
Graduate School	The remainder of the program can be completed within one year (Fall, Spring, Summer terms) if you attend full-time. You also have the option to complete the program part time and/or in the online mode. You are eligible to matriculate following graduation from Le

Moyne College, and if you choose to study in our campus program you will receive at 25% Le Moyne scholarship

**M.S. in Information Systems ONLY** – Le Moyne students graduating with a computer science or information systems degree are awarded a waiver of six credit hours and are only required to complete 36 credit hours.

NOTE – Le Moyne student enroll as non-matriculated undergraduate students through Syracuse University College of Professional Studies. After receiving a bachelor's degree, the graduate credits earned to that point will be transferred into the graduate program. These courses CANNOT be used to meet requirements for an undergraduate degree. Loans from Government agencies intended for undergraduate education cannot be used to fund these courses.
