LE MOYNE COLLEGE MISSION STATEMENT



Le Moyne College is a diverse learning community that strives for academic excellence in the Catholic and Jesuit tradition through its comprehensive programs rooted in the liberal arts and sciences. Its emphasis is on education of the whole person and on the search for meaning and value as integral parts of the intellectual life. ACADEMIC REGALIA



The origin of academic caps, gowns and hoods dates to the 12th century and the rise of the universities, which were originally under the auspices of the church, and whose faculties were comprised of churchmen. These scholars wore clerical robes, hoods and capes as much for warmth during the long, cold European winters as for distinction.

Today the standard academic regalia worn in the United States are of three types. The bachelor's gown is characterized by its simplicity of line and long, pointed sleeves, distinguishing it from the master's gown, best recognized by its rectangular, "wing-like" sleeves. The doctor's gown, with full, bell-shaped sleeves, is faced in front and back with velvet and has three velvet bars across the sleeves. In addition, the tassel on the doctor's cap may be gold.

The hood is the most symbolic part of the academic regalia. Its size and shape indicate the level of the degree held, its lining shows the colors of the institution granting it, and the color of its velvet border corresponds to the general academic program of the degree. Thus, all Le Moyne hoods are lined with green and gold, the College colors. Among the hoods worn by Le Moyne graduates and faculty, most have borders of one of the following colors: white (arts and letters) for those with the degree of Bachelor of Arts or Master of Arts; golden yellow (science), corresponding to the degree of Bachelor of Science or Master of Science; and dark blue (philosophy), worn by faculty holding the degree of Doctor of Philosophy in various academic disciplines. Other colors worn by Le Moyne faculty and administrative personnel, indicating the master's or doctor's degree they hold, include crimson (theology), purple (law), drab (business administration) and light blue (education).

HONORARY DEGREE RECIPIENTS



NANCY E. CANTOR, PH.D.

Throughout her career, Nancy Cantor has distinguished herself as a thoughtful, forward-thinking leader in American higher education. She has, in the words of one colleague, “an uncanny ability to absorb and process information, read the momentum of our culture, envision novel solutions that address the ‘double bottom line’ of doing well and doing good, and – crucially – the fortitude of mind required to lead others out of inertia and into action.” Central to this work is Dr. Cantor’s belief that colleges and universities do not merely shape lives; they shape communities.

In her current role as the 11th chancellor and president of Syracuse University, Dr. Cantor has led that institution in pursuing cross-sector collaborations in the City of Syracuse that simultaneously enrich scholarship and education, and change the face of this older industrial city. The university’s engagement in areas of critical importance such as environmental sustainability; art, technology and design; and neighborhood and cultural entrepreneurship have revitalized and re-energized Syracuse, and earned Syracuse University the distinction of being among the first institutions to receive the Carnegie Foundation for the Advancement of Teaching’s classification as a university committed to community engagement. It also garnered Dr. Cantor the 2008 Carnegie Corporation Academic Leadership Award. Dr. Cantor has also worked to create valuable, long-lasting connections between Le Moyne and Syracuse’s iSchool, L.C. Smith College of Engineering, and Maxwell School of Citizenship and Public Affairs.

A prolific scholar, Dr. Cantor lectures and writes extensively on the pivotal role universities play in their communities, and about myriad other issues facing higher education, from racial justice and diversity to sustainability to rewarding public scholarship. This work is informed first and foremost by her experiences. Prior to her appointment at Syracuse, Dr. Cantor served as chancellor of the University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign and provost and executive vice president for academic affairs at the University of Michigan. She understands well the challenges and nuances of leading a large university, whether public or private. Early in her career, she was chair of the psychology department at Princeton University, later becoming a professor of psychology and senior research scientist at Michigan. Today, as chancellor of Syracuse University, Dr. Cantor also holds a joint appointment as distinguished professor of psychology and women’s studies at Syracuse’s College of Arts and Sciences.

Perhaps more than anything else, Dr. Cantor models for the next generation of leaders not to be daunted by challenges that may present themselves, but to face them with calmness, patience and confidence, and with the humility to accept that we cannot overcome them alone. As one person who has worked closely with her throughout her time at Syracuse noted, she would likely concur with philosopher John Dewey that dependence upon others “denotes a power rather than a weakness” and that the “illusion of being really able to stand and act alone [is] an unnamed form of insanity which is responsible for a large part of the remediable suffering of the world.”

Beyond her outstanding work at Syracuse University, Dr. Cantor is a member of the boards of the American Institutes for Research, the New York Academy of Sciences, the University of California at Davis Board of Advisors, and Say Yes to Education, in addition to being past chair of the board of directors of the American Association for Higher Education and former chair of the board of the American Council on Education. She also generously shares her time and expertise with our community as co-chair of the Central New York Regional Economic Development Council.

THOMAS G. YOUNG '69

“Love is shown more in deeds than words.” – St. Ignatius of Loyola

Thomas Young's actions reveal the depth and breadth of his devotion to this community and its citizens.

A member of the Le Moyne class of 1969, Mr. Young went on to become an able, dedicated public official. He served as the mayor of Syracuse for two terms, from 1986 to 1993. During that time, the city earned national recognition from two presidential administrations for outstanding achievements in urban revitalization and housing and neighborhood renewal. Syracuse residents also saw their quality of life improve, as Mr. Young focused his attention on restoring the city's aging elementary schools and invigorating neighborhoods by establishing the Syracuse Housing Partnership, a coalition of neighborhood, business and civic leaders committed to affordable home ownership. Beyond that, Mr. Young also worked to strengthen the city's economy, creating the Downtown Task Force, which was responsible for a multi-million dollar revitalization project that fostered a rebirth in Syracuse's downtown business district. Prior to serving as mayor, Mr. Young worked for a decade as the executive director of the New York State Fair. The impact of his work in both of these roles will be seen far into the future.

Since leaving public office two decades ago, Mr. Young has remained deeply invested in the community, helping with the search for a new superintendent for the Syracuse City School District and the implementation of the district's strategic plan; offering his support and assistance to candidates in city- and county-wide elections; and giving his time to numerous civic and charitable organizations, including many designed to aid the next generation of community leaders, such as OnPoint For College, Elmcrest Children's Center and the CNY Local Education Fund. Those closest to Mr. Young say that, as when he held elected office, he continues to distinguish himself as someone with tremendous empathy for others. The extensive list of community institutions that have benefited from his counsel includes the Greater Syracuse Chamber of Commerce, Everson Museum, Health Science Center at Syracuse University, and Catholic Charities.

Deeply committed to the cause of education, Mr. Young has generously shared his time and talent with his alma mater, serving on both the board of regents and the board of trustees. In 2001, he was recognized for his work on the Heights and across our region with the Simon Le Moyne Award, the College's highest honor. In both his professional and personal pursuits, Mr. Young channels his energy and focus to help his friends, neighbors and community. He is, in the truest sense, a person for others.

PETER C. MAJOR, M.H.M '60

Many people talk about living a life of service. Some even dream of it. But through his work with the men, women and children in South Sudan, now the Republic of South Sudan, Father Peter Major is the rare individual who lives such a life. He is humble, kind and generous, and he is devoted to helping those less fortunate on a truly global scale.

The son of The Hon. Charles T. Major and Anne Elizabeth Curtin Major, Peter Major grew up in Skaneateles, and went on to graduate from Le Moyne in 1960 with a bachelor's degree in economics and to attend law school in Albany, N.Y. During that time, though, something changed for him. Instead of continuing to pursue a career in law, he chose to study for the priesthood at Mill Hill Missionaries in England. He was ordained in 1968.

Over the past 45 years, Father Major has traveled the world, selflessly committing his life to others. He served as a missionary first in Borneo, working for 10 years in the interior rain forests, where he mastered not only the Dyak language but birdcalls as well. Father Major then went to Cairo, Egypt, and, from there, to the southern part of Sudan, where he worked with black Christians. When war broke out in that nation in 1982, Father Major was held hostage for nearly two months before being released. After being freed, he did not flee, but remained in the country that had come to mean so much to him, establishing a parish for displaced people in Khartoum. Today Father Major serves in Malakal in the burgeoning Republic of South Sudan, where he ministers to hospital patients, homeless children and prison inmates. With characteristic humility, he has said of his work simply, "It's where I'm called by God to be."

Wherever his travels have taken him, Father Major has been at all times a priest, a friend, and a good neighbor. He has done what the Christ of Matthew's Gospel calls upon all of us to do if we are to enter the kingdom of heaven: "For I was hungry and you gave me something to eat, I was thirsty and you gave me something to drink, I was a stranger and you invited me in, I needed clothes and you clothed me, I was sick and you looked after me, I was in prison and you came to visit me ... Truly I tell you, whatever you did for one of the least of these brothers and sisters of mine, you did for me."

As one friend so aptly put it: "Other graduates have made more money or gained more notoriety; none have lived a better life than Father Peter Major."

A LOOK BACK:

HIGHLIGHTS OF THE 2012-13 ACADEMIC YEAR

- The College earned accolades for its academic excellence and value in several national rankings. For the fourth consecutive year, Le Moyne was named one of the best colleges in the Northeast by The Princeton Review and, for the 21st year in a row, *U.S. News and World Report* ranked Le Moyne as one of America's "Best Colleges" based on its academic quality. The College also was named one of the 500 best colleges in the U.S. by *Forbes* magazine for the fifth time in as many years.
- Members of the Le Moyne community joined people around the world in offering prayers of support to the newly elected Pope Francis, the first Jesuit pontiff in history. Numerous TV, radio and print reporters interviewed members of Le Moyne's Jesuit community about the selection of the new pope.
- Jennifer Glancy, professor of religious studies, and Karmen MacKendrick, professor of philosophy, received funding from the National Endowment for the Humanities' Enduring Questions grant program to develop an interdisciplinary core course addressing the question, "What does prayer do?" This marks the second time in three years that Le Moyne faculty members have received funding from the highly competitive Enduring Questions grant program. Jennifer Gurley from the English department previously received funding to develop a seminar addressing the question, "Why do humans write?"
- Le Moyne unveiled its first Alumni House. Located at 546 Fayette Boulevard, the home has been refurbished to serve the needs of alumni, with meeting spaces, high-speed Internet access, and a large-screen television with USB and computer capabilities. It also serves as the home to Le Moyne's Office of Alumni and Parent Programs.
- Kelsey Woodrick '13 was selected for a Fulbright U.S. student award for 2013-2014 in Thailand, where she will serve as a teaching assistant in English classes. Sponsored by the U.S. Department of State, the highly competitive Fulbright program provides funding for students, scholars, teachers and professionals to undertake graduate study, advanced research and teaching. Woodrick majored in English with concentrations in literature and Teaching English to Speakers of Other Languages, and minored in anthropology.
- Several innovative academic programs were introduced at the College, including a Higher Education Leadership Certificate, Adult Education Certificate and Certificate in Health Care Leadership.
- Le Moyne Provost Linda LeMura, Ph.D., was one of only 14 individuals selected to represent the 28 Jesuit colleges and universities in the U.S. at a meeting with Adolfo Nicolás, superior general of the Society of Jesus. The participants discussed the future of Jesuit higher education, the challenges it faces, and how they can work together to best prepare their students for success.
- Work was completed on a \$3 million renovation to the LaCasse Dining Center, primarily sponsored by Sodexo, the College's food service provider. The new dining center is set up to be similar to a food court, with multiple stations where food is prepared to order. As many local ingredients are used as possible.
- Le Moyne received a \$2 million grant from New York's Regional Economic Development Council program. The funds will be used to assist with the renovation of Mitchell Hall, which will house the Madden School of Business, and the Coyne Science Center, which is being renovated as part of a \$45 million investment in the sciences at Le Moyne.

- Several nursing students and faculty members traveled to Worawora, Ghana, where they volunteered at a remote hospital; conducted vision, hearing and blood pressure screenings at two clinics in the area; and visited patients in their homes. In addition, Mary Springston, director of the College's physician assistant studies program, traveled to the Republic of South Sudan, where she worked with officials from the country's Department of HIV/AIDS to deliver medicine, supplies and educational materials throughout the area known as Torit.
- The 2012 Founders' Day Gala, which honored alumni and longtime supporters of the College Armand '57 and Joan '88 Cincotta, drew an estimated 700 attendees. The event raised \$185,000 to benefit the College's commitment to student scholarship and financial support. Meanwhile, another event, Le Moyne in New York: A Tribute to Jesuit Leadership, was held to honor Mike Madden '71 and J. Donald Monan, S.J., for their innumerable contributions to the College. It raised \$135,000 for the Le Moyne College Fund, which helps support student scholarship and financial aid.
- Le Moyne officials introduced a new high-tech way to show off the College's facilities using Google Business Photos, a technology that provides virtual tours of the interior of buildings. It allows individuals to tour key buildings on the Le Moyne campus online, virtually walking through buildings and viewing a facility using 360-degree functionality.
- Caitlin McGuire '13 was named by Campus Compact as a 2013 Newman Civic Fellow, becoming the first Le Moyne student to receive that honor. Majoring in communication and Spanish, Caitlin uses her skills in social media, blogging, Web design and public relations to motivate and inspire her peers to engage in social justice advocacy. Newman Civic Fellow awards are made in memory of Dr. Frank Newman, a founder of Campus Compact, who dedicated his life to creating systemic change through education reform.
- The College hosted a series of events to mark the 50th anniversary of what is widely regarded to be the most significant ecumenical event of modern times, the Second Vatican Council. The events – which included two public lectures by prominent theologians and a concert featuring music inspired by the council – sought to establish a dialogue about the role the church plays in people's lives today.
- Martha Grabowski, Ph.D., was selected as the inaugural McDevitt Chair in Information Systems. In this role, Grabowski works on some of the newest frontiers of large-scale systems research. Grabowski, who has been at Le Moyne since 1987, has served the College as a professor of business administration and director of Le Moyne's information systems program.
- Le Moyne was named to the 2013 list of Military Friendly Schools, released by *G.I. Jobs* magazine. The list honors the top 15 percent of Colleges that are doing the most to embrace America's veterans as students. Criteria for making the Military Friendly Schools list includes efforts to recruit and retain military and veteran students, results in recruiting military students, and academic accreditations.
- Tyler Sperrazza '13, a history and theatre arts double major, was honored as a History Scholar by the Gilder Lehrman Institute of American History. This prestigious award is given to only 15 graduating seniors across the country who specialize in American history and who are "thoughtful and dedicated in their studies, and who have also shown leadership in and out of the classroom."
