In recognition of "It's On Us!" week, we wanted to share with you the resources available to the campus community regarding sexual harassment and misconduct. Le Moyne College has established policies and procedures to address sexual harassment and sexual misconduct reports. The policies and procedures are set forth in the Student Handbook and the Employee Guidelines. All students and employees should read the corresponding policy, which can be found at www.lemoyne.edu/assaultresources.

Under Title IX, 'sexual harassment' and sexual misconduct includes incidents of sexual assault, rape, dating violence, domestic violence and stalking. When a report of sexual misconduct or harassment is made, the College will respond to stop the alleged behavior, prevent it from reoccurring, and address its effects.
