All Veterans with a JST or CCAF transcript receive a minimum of 3 free elective credits. Up to 15 free elective credits can be transferred from appropriate training. Credit for direct transfer in the sciences, communications, management, etc. is evaluated on an individual basis. Veterans who have deployed and/or received training in another language may be eligible for transfer credit or a waiver for the Core Encountering Another Culture requirement.**
