ESL 115 and ESL 116 will not transfer into Le Moyne.

Students must receive a grade of C- or higher to receive transfer credit.

\*\*Maximum of 60 credits/20 courses accepted for transfer credit.

\*\*\*MAT 151 at OCC recommended. If MAT 151 is not taken at OCC, MTH 111 must be taken in the first year at Le Moyne. Any other accepted math course will count as a free elective. See Core Articulation agreement for a list of accepted math courses.

†Do not take PSY 206 at OCC if PSY 204 & PSY 207 have been taken at OCC. Conversely, do not take PSY 204 & 207 if PSY 206 has been taken.

††Must earn 120 total credits for degree, additional free elective credit may be required.

Must take at least 6 core courses at LMC, 1 course must be writing instructional, COR 400 must be taken at LMC.
