 - **PLEASE REFRAIN FROM HAVING FINAL EXAMS DURING THE FINAL WEEK OF REGULAR CLASSES AND/OR ENDING CLASSES EARLY. COLLEGE POLICY:** This is not merely a "number of class meetings" issue--although it is that, too, as courses are meant to run for a specific number of credit hours, and faculty are expected to teach for the full term. The Dean's offices had complaints from faculty that students were skipping their regular classes because other faculty had scheduled an exam during the last week, and the students felt they needed to study.
