

Occupational Therapy

Per U.S. Federal Regulations, 34 CFR §668.14 and §668.43, the following disclosures related to the educational requirements for professional certification and licensure in New York State and other states and U.S. territories is provided.

Le Moyne College's occupational therapy program is ACOTE® accredited. Occupational therapy and occupational therapy assistant educational programs that are ACOTE® accredited satisfy the educational requirements in all states, the District of Columbia, and Puerto Rico. Students graduating from an ACOTE® accredited occupational therapy and occupational therapy assistant educational program are eligible to take the National Board for Certification in Occupational Therapy (NBCOT) certification exam and are eligible to apply for licensure in all states, the District of Columbia, and Puerto Rico. Le Moyne College has designed the curriculum that when successfully completed meets the educational requirements for professional licensure in New York State.
